Meeting Minutes

February 2024 Tri-County Barnstormer Meeting minutes

Meeting called to order at 7:30 pm February 1st 2024 at the Friendship Center in Conroe TX with 16 members and 2 visitors present.

Secretary report: Minutes from November and December were approved by unanimous voice vote.

Treasury report: Current roster is 124 members. Bank balance is healthy with all major bills covered till after our next renewal cycle.

<u>Vice President report</u>: The field house and equipment survived the deep freeze events we had. Water was drained and heaters added to the water areas to prevent busted pipes and the work paid off with no damage at the field. The tree piles were burned. One pile has been leveled and the remaining unburned items were mounded together for another burn attempt. Two pistons from the John Deere bucket were rebuilt. Volunteer activities are available at the field for repairs or support of the flying events. Use the signup sheet and email the VP with your work activities.

Old business:

4 events are scheduled/planned for the field this year. A budget set aside of \$1k per event was voted and approved for a total of \$4k to be available to cover the costs for food, supplies, and prizes.

New Business:

5 new members, Full Members Kevin Murphey, Bobby Tyson, and Felix Flores, Jr. Member Levi Strickland and Associate Member Duncan Strickland.

A member asked to buy 1 acre of land from the club. A vote was taken and the proposal did not pass with unanimous negative vote.
